D. Kyle Hogarth is Professor of Medicine at the University of Chicago. He runs the pulmonary rehab program and is director of Interventional Bronchoscopy and Advanced Bronchoscopy. He was trained at University of Chicago for pulmonary and critical care and went to Case Western Reserve for Medical School.

An earlier adopter of technology, he started the UofC program by being the first in his state to utilize superDimension to access the periphery. His work in the periphery has evolved to the 2nd generation robotic system and he was the first to use the new Noah Galaxy continuous image integrated robotic system.

He has been on the editorial board of many journals and has been involved in the bronchoscopy training of hundreds of fellows.
